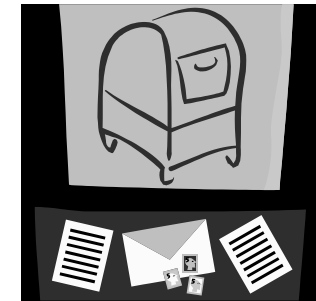



How does Borrow by Mail work?

- 1) Apply for your free NWT library card.
- 2) Decide what books and other things you want to borrow.
- 3) Contact NWT Public Library Services and tell them what you want to borrow.
- 4) Receive the books and other things through the mail – free.
- 5) Check the date that you need to send them back. 
- 6) Use the free shipping label to mail things back to the library.
- 7) Borrow more things.

What can I borrow?

Borrow up to 5 things at one time
- 3 things on the same topic

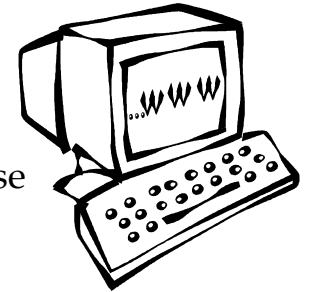
- Books 
- Audio books
- CDs 
- DVDs
- Videos
- Specific titles or authors
- Information about a certain topic – such as travelling to China, training dogs, or how to make a drum.

What libraries can I borrow from?

Borrow from any library in the NWT or other parts of Canada. The length of time you keep things depends on the library.
